

DONATION POLICY

Suncoast Humane Society Thrift Stores accept quality donated items for resale. Occasionally, however, we receive unusable or hazardous goods. The cost to the humane society to properly dispose of these items is expensive and wastes funding that could otherwise support the mission of the Suncoast Humane Society.

- In general, all donated items should be **gently-used, clean and in working condition.**
- **Furniture** must be in **good condition, structurally sound** and have **no stains, rips, holes or discoloration.**
- Store space may be limited, so consider donating **seasonal items at the right time.** It is much easier to sell **Christmas Trees** in November than in February.
- If your donation is **electronics, appliances or battery-operated items** make sure they work. We are unable to repair these items. If you donate a **broken item**, it can be expensive for us to properly dispose of it.
- **We do not accept Mattresses or Box Springs, Household hazardous waste items, cleaners, fluorescent lamps, paint, fresh produce or live plants.**
- Speak with a Manager at one of the three Stores before donating large appliances, televisions or furniture.
- Please have all items being pick-up on the first floor and disassembled for the safety of our driver and assistant.
- **Our drivers and Store Manager reserve the right to decline a donation that is not suitable for our stores.**
